This expression of the series was brewed in the summer of 2022, aged in wine barrels, and then hopped with hand-selected Motueka hops from Freestyle Farm—our agricultural partner, in Upper Moutere, New Zealand—and handselected Hallertauer Blanc hops from Seitz Farm—our agricultural partner in Wolnzach, Germany.

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#### GREEN DOT (5% ABV)

Brewed in the Fall of 2022 and fermented with our mixed culture. The grist was comprised of Valley Pilsen malt and Nitty Gritty Grain company raw Redeemer wheat. After primary fermentation in oak the beer was aged in white wine barrels. In September 2023 one and two year barrels of Green Dot were blended and aged further on whole cone Czech Saaz hops. Conditioned naturally in the bottle in early 2024 with raw VT wildflower honey.

Pale Ale. Historically used to treat scurvy by early colonists, spruce tips have long been steeped in beer and tea for its high vitamin C content. Piney, woody and resinous this Spruce Ale layers on top of a gentle malt backbone.
