ADMISSION

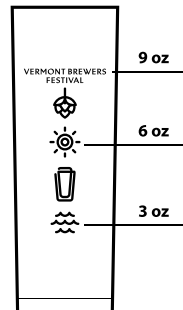
- Please know this is a tasting festival. Anyone showing signs of intoxication will not be admitted to the event and/or may be asked to leave. There are no exceptions or refunds.
- All attendees must be 21 years of age and provide valid proof of ID

- Please try to make your sampling choice before entering the tasting line in order to not hold up the line for others
- Additional beer tasting wristbands are \$10 for 5 tickets and are available at the Vermont Brewers Association tent. One additional tasting wristband sold per person.
- Additional tasting wristbands may be purchased up until the last hour of each session.
- Please remember this is a tasting festival. If you do not use all your tickets, please do not give them to anyone else. By Vermont law the festival cannot over-serve. Brewed by members of the Vermont Brewers Association Board, this Juicy Oat Pale was built around the connections that keep our brewing community growing. Locally grown Valley Malt Pils, Vermont-grown flaked oats, and flaked wheat from NEK Grains meets Briess pilsner malt to create a soft, easy-drinking foundation. Whirlpool additions of Champlain Valley Hops Cascade and Hopsteiner Comet Salvo lead into a dry hop of Whitefield Hop Yard Leopold- a native VT hop and Segal Ranch Tangier—a pairing made possible through relationships built with the New York Hop Guild. The result is bright and expressive, with layers of grapefruit, orange, ripe tropical fruits, and a gentle, pillowy body. Brewed exclusively for the Vermont Brewers Festival, it's a celebration of the people, partnerships, and shared passion that make great beer possible.
